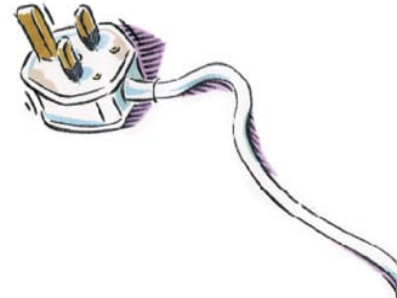


Is in-house PAT testing keeping you safe?

Some of our clients carried out their own PAT testing until they saw the advantages of getting our help.


Remember, stickers on your plugs won't help if your staff haven't **carried out the tests properly** and **given you advice** so you can **improve electrical safety**.

Comparison Checklist (we hope this will help you make a safe decision)

Make sure your inspection regime offers these benefits to protect your business and staff:	 TEST Inspect electrical safety & service contractors	Your in-house PAT system
Takes account of the environment the items are used in - for example if they're near water, dust, impact (e.g. in a workshop), children, you need advice. Suggests ways to improve the location or use of the equipment, such as moving plugs from near sinks.	✓	
Carries out full visual checks on each item, and tests according to the timetable recommended by the IEE and NICEIC.	✓	
Has sufficient knowledge of circuitry to be aware of damage, identifying visible deterioration which could be dangerous.	✓	
Takes the correct time to test and advise properly (i.e. are not rushing and lacking concentration).	✓	
Uses equipment which is modern and regularly calibrated.	✓	
While testing, can review your lighting to advise you on how you can save energy .	✓	
Undergoes <i>practical</i> training and stays up to date with rules.	✓	
Checks fuses and leads, and ensures plugs are a safe type.	✓
